According to NFPA 750, all water mist fire protection systems must be installed following the manufacturer's design, installation manual, and specific certification requirements. This ensures that all installations meet approved configurations, maintaining system effectiveness and safeguarding property and lives.

Certification Process Through the Plumis LMS

Upon passing the assessment, you'll receive a Technical Certificate, valid for two years. This certificate can be submitted to Authorities Having Jurisdiction (AHJs) as proof of your competency and authorization to install Automist systems.
